A School of the Classics

Covenant Christian Academy (CCA) was founded by parents who wanted their children to experience a rigorous classical education from a distinctly Christian perspective. Our mission is to train students to see the Lordship of Christ in every sphere of life and to gain the education they need to serve effectively in God's kingdom.

Curriculum: a distinctly classical approach

The CCA curriculum is based on a distinctive educational philosophy known as the "classical method" and is doctrinally grounded in Reformed theology. These combined features make it unique among Christian and government schools in the Harrisburg area. Schools in early American history were typically classical and Christian, but this method actually dates from the medieval period and is defined by three stages of learning known collectively as the **Trivium**. The three stages of the Trivium correspond well to a child's normal cognitive development. In addition, we have an untiring, ongoing commitment to maintaining a smaller class size, choosing the best available curriculum in each discipline, and when possible using scholarly translations of original works in addition to quality text books.

A Biblical, Christian Worldview

Covenant Christian Academy provides an education that fully integrates the Word of God into its substantive curriculum and teaches that all life, knowledge and meaning extend from the Creator. Our Christianity is more than simply a religion class among many other classes; it is a commitment to presenting the Lord as the One in whom all knowledge is united. Central to this is the view that all subjects, be they history, art, music, mathematics, or science, must be taught in the light of God's existence and his revelation to humanity through his Son, Jesus Christ. (*Colossians 1:15-18, Hebrews 1:3*).

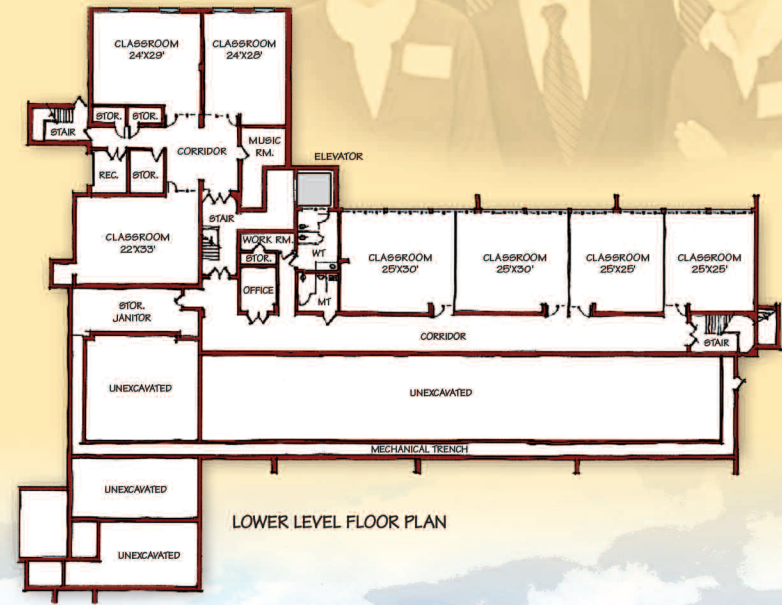
